# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS** | 20101 Electronic Key Cabinet

#### **INITIAL SET-UP**

- 1. All key cabinets are shipped locked.
- **2.** To open the key cabinet, remove the small center cover plate on the front panel.
- **3.** Insert override key into the keyhole. Turn in a counter-clockwise direction and turn the knob in a clockwise direction and pull to open the cabinet.
- 4. Remove the battery cover plate (image 2) on the back of the safe drawer. Insert batteries into battery compartment (use 4 AA batteries). Alkaline batteries are recommended for best performance.

#### SET INDIVIDUAL CODES

- 1. Press the red button on the inside of the door (Image 2)
- 2. Push button and release.
- **3.** You will hear 2 beeps from the front of the door and the yellow light on the front of the safe that reads "proceed" will be lit.
- Press between 3 to 5 numbers that you wish to use as your new personal code and confirm by pressing A or B within 15 seconds.
- **5.** If you do not complete the process properly, you will have to start over from step 1.

### **CHANGING THE BATTERY**

- 1. Red light indicates low battery (image 1).
- **2.** To test the batteries, just input your personal code to open the door.
- 3. If the batteries are low, the red light will be on.
- **4.** Replace the batteries with 4 AA batteries and reprogram the key cabinet using steps 1-5 above (Image 2).



## **OVERRIDE KEY**

- For your convenience, we have engineered a manual override sytem for your key cabinet. If you forget or misplace your code, follow the instructions below.
  - **1.** To open the key cabinet, remove the small center cover plate on the front panel.
  - **2.** Insert the key into the key hole and turn it in a counter-clockwise direction. Turn the knob in a clockwise direction and pull.

Be sure to store the override key in a secure location. DO NOT STORE OVERRIDE KEYS IN THE SAFE
